Operation Rainbow Australia

Operation Rainbow successfully completed another surgical mission in Cebu in the Philippines. In June, our dedicated team returned to VisayasMed Hospital for the second consecutive year, demonstrating our ongoing commitment to improving healthcare outcomes in the Philippines.

This mission, we welcomed over 130 patients and their families from across the region to clinic day. During our 6 days at VisayasMed, our team performed 89 procedures on 84 patients, significantly enhancing their quality of life.

The mission's success was largely due to the collaboration and expertise of our diverse team members, including a majority of members from St. John of God Hospital as well as Perth Children's Hospital and Cambridge Day Surgery Hospital.

We greatly value the essential support provided by our local partners and nurses in the Philippines.
